Students from Kindergarten through 12th grade have a **required** summer reading assignment. All summer reading assignments for grades Incoming K - 12 can be found on the district website at www.plainedgeschools.org. Information will also be posted regarding assistance that will be available over the summer to answer questions that high school students may have. Copies of these assignments, as well as those for most Advanced Placement and college level courses will be available on the district website until the start of school in September.

We are also excited to continue our *Plainedge Reader Leader* program. Students who read three books <u>in addition</u> to the required assignment will be rewarded as a Plainedge Reader Leader. These three books can be any books. Students will have their picture posted in the school library and receive a certificate from the district. Students will also receive a special reward from a local business establishment. These three books can also be used towards the Plainedge Public Library Summer Reading Program (grades K-5). Suggested book lists will be posted on the district website and available in the school libraries and public library.
