Teachers that will say great things about you and speak about you as a student in his/her class.

How Much Time Do They Need?

Ask ASAP if you have not done so already

YOUR COLLEGE ESSAY

2022-2023 COMMON APPLICATION ESSAY PROMPTS

Some students have a background, identity, interest, or talent that is so meaningful they believe their application would be incomplete without it. If this sounds like you, then please share your story.

The lessons we take from obstacles we encounter can be fundamental to later success. Recount a time when you faced a challenge, setback, or failure. How did it affect you, and what did you learn from the experience?

Reflect on a time when you questioned or challenged a belief or idea. What prompted your thinking? What was the outcome?

YOUR COLLEGE ESSAY

2022-2023 COMMON APPLICATION ESSAY PROMPTS

Reflect on something that someone has done for you that has made you happy or thankful in a surprising way. How has this gratitude affected or motivated you?

Discuss an accomplishment, event, or realization that sparked a period of personal growth and a new understanding of yourself or others.

Describe a topic, idea, or concept you find so engaging that it makes you lose all track of time. Why does it captivate you? What or who do you turn to when you want to learn more?

Share an essay on any topic of your choice. It can be one you've already written, one that responds to a different prompt, or one of your own design.



APPLICATION METHODS

ROLLING ADMISSIONS

No application deadline
The earlier you apply the better
Applications reviewed as colleges get them

REGULAR ADMISSIONS

Specific deadlines

Notification of acceptance in the spring



APPLICATION METHODS

EARLY DECISION

Applications due EARLY NOVEMBER

Students get decision by mid-December

If accepted - student bound by contractual agreement to attend college and withdraw all other applications

EARLY ACTION

Similar to Early Decision in that you apply early No binding agreement

SAT & ACT TESTING DATES & DEADLINES



**October 1, 2022 - Registration Deadline - September 2, 2022 (Sept. 20)*

**November 6, 2022 - Registration Deadline - October 7, 2022 (Oct. 25)*

**December 3, 2022 - Registration Deadline - November 3, 2022 (Nov. 22)*



October 22, 2022 - Registration Deadline - September 16, 2022 (Sept. 30)* **December 10, 2022 - Registration Deadline - November 4, 2022 (Nov. 11)*





STEPS TO APPLY

Senior questionnaire, parent brag sheet, transcript release, and personal profile should be completed and submitted.

Submit Online Applications

(Make sure you provide your counselor's correct contact info – email address)

If required, have SAT and ACT scores sent to schools directly from test company. However please be aware of college's process-some will ask you to self report and send official scores later.

Submit College Tracking Form (pick up form in Guidance Office). Please submit at least two weeks prior to deadline.

INSTANT DECISION DAYS

Application fee waived

Students must meet or exceed admission criteria to apply

If interested DO NOT apply via another method

Counselors will give specifics of application requirements and list of participating colleges/universities - late September - early October

Applications due October 28
