The Plainedge Community

The Plainedge School District is located in Nassau County in the suburban community of North Massapequa on the south shore of Long Island, forty miles east of New York City.

Its population of 22,000 is employed in nearby New York City and on Long Island in various professions, such as, technology, service industries, and family businesses. The community takes pride in the accomplishments of its students, and its support of quality education is demonstrated by the high school’s innovative and challenging programs of study.

Three elementary schools, (two K-5 and one Pre-K-5), one middle school grades 6-8, and one senior high school grades 9-12 serve the approximately 3,000 students enrolled in pre-kindergarten through grade 12.

Program of Study

The high school curriculum includes four levels of college preparatory instruction: Regents, Honors, College and Advanced Placement. Honors and Regents classes are offered at most grade levels for most core academic subjects.

Academic electives include creative writing, public speaking and debate, criminal justice, psychology, sociology, engineering, astronomy, forensic science, marine biology, and film studies. Our research program allows students to explore research and its many components within the humanities and sciences, including collecting and analyzing data, electronic information retrieval and preparing abstracts. Seniors submit papers to the Regeneron Science Talent Search.

A wide variety of technology, business, art, and music courses are offered. Internships are also available to juniors and seniors.

Technology is infused into the instructional program. All computers are networked with high speed internet access, and a wide area network connects all district schools. In addition, all students are provided school district Chrome-books.

As a result of the COVID-19 pandemic New York State cancelled Regents exams for June 2021, August 2021 and January 2022. Students who passed the course that would have culminated in the Regents exam are exempted from taking the exam. Additionally if a student was registered to retake an exam on one of these dates he/she is also exempt.

Co-Curricular Activities

Co-curricular activities are an important extension of the academic program. A wide range of clubs and other activities, including community service and subject area clubs, as well as junior varsity and varsity interscholastic sports are offered.

Elimination of Class Rank

To avoid unnecessary competition among students and promote a more balanced representation of a student’s achievement, Plainedge High School does not rank seniors. Class rank information will not be provided on the high school transcript. The transcript will provide a GPA for the first three years of high school which includes all courses except physical education, Regents review classes and special education support classes. After the first semester of senior year, the GPA will be recalculated to include senior grades for the first semester and will be posted on the mid-year transcript.

Grades in Pre-Calculus AB, Physics, honors, college and advanced placement courses are weighted and calculated in the GPA. Pre-Calculus AB, Physics, honors and college courses receive 5% weight and AP courses receive 10% weight. Accelerated high school courses taken in eighth grade are computed into the GPA.
