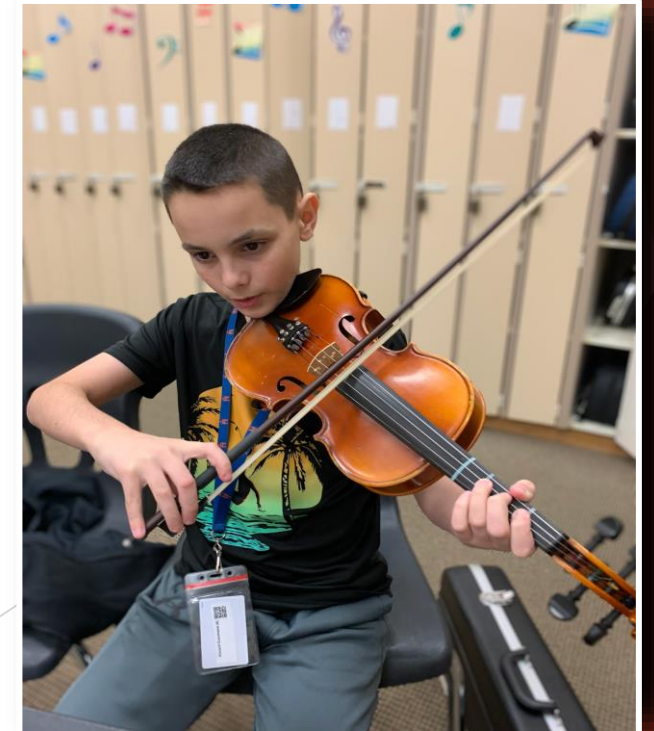

Online program:

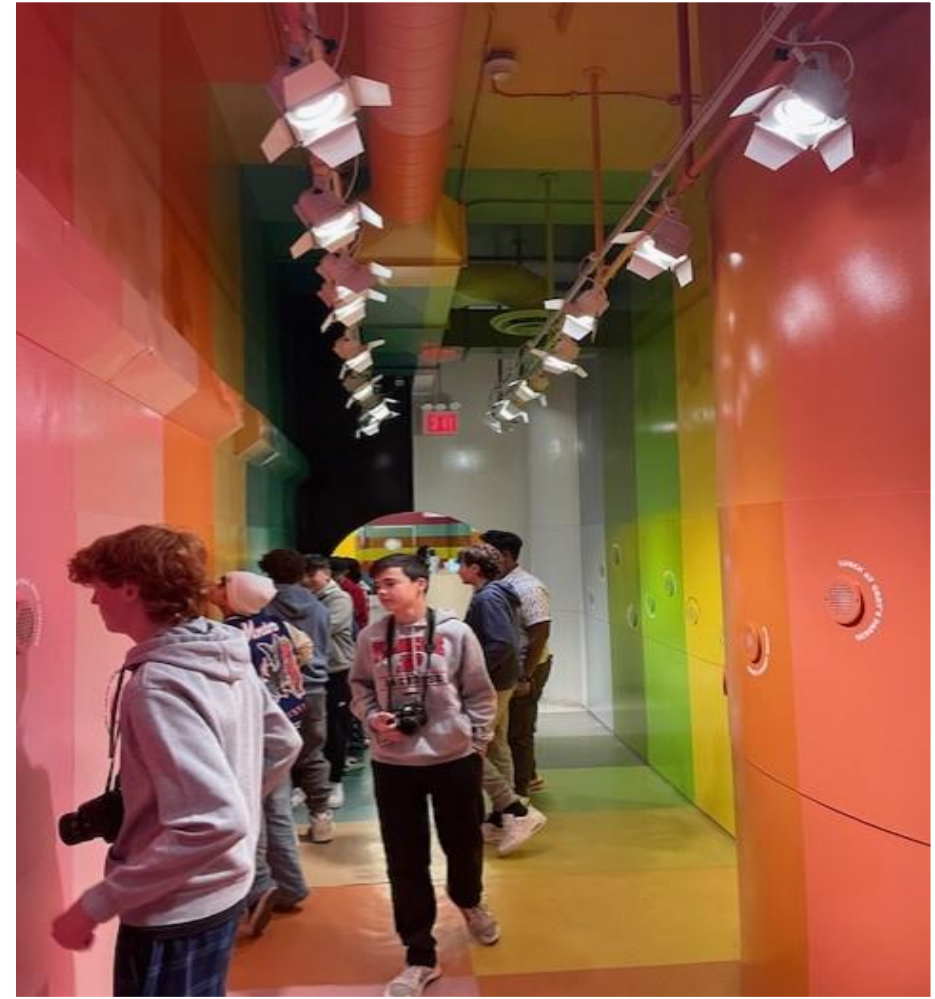

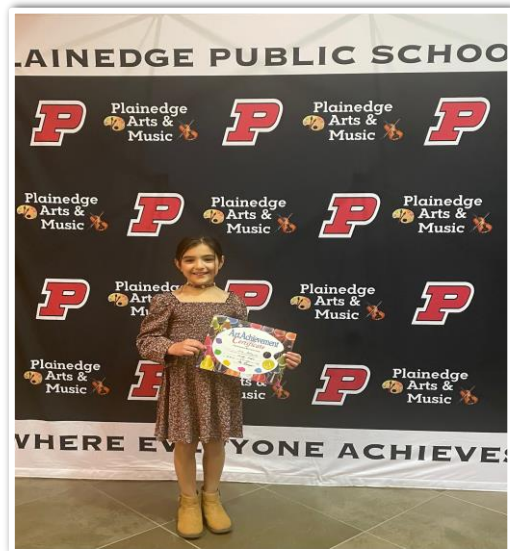

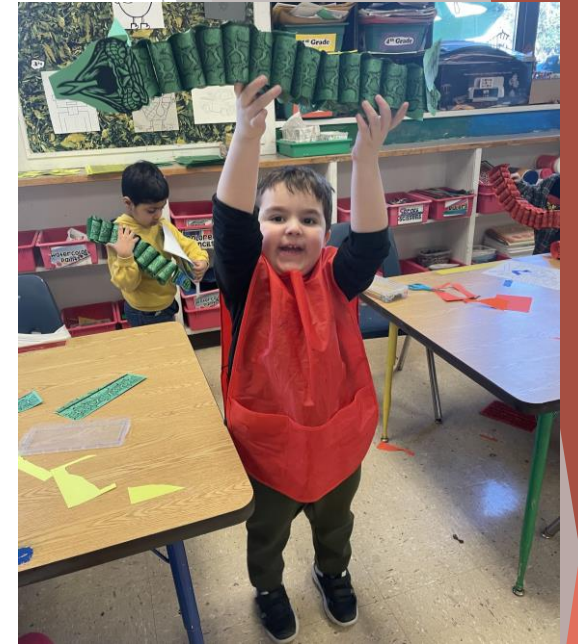
