STUDENT SAFETY AND SECURITY

Policies and Procedures

<u>Procedure Performed:</u> We reviewed the District's policies and procedures with regard to the internal controls related to student safety and security.

<u>Findings</u>: We noted the District did not adopt the legally required policy School Safety and Educational Climate (SSEC) Reporting required by 8 NYCRR §100.2(gg)(5). We noted the District does complete the required *SSEC Summary Data Collection* forms to ensure the District has a system in place to track and report information about violent and disruptive behavior to NYSED.

Recommendation: We recommend the District adopt the legally required policy required by 8 NYCRR §100.2(gg)(5). We noted the Board adopted policy no. 5170, *School Safety and Educational Climate Reporting* on May 7, 2024.

<u>Procedure Performed:</u> We reviewed the District's procedures for emergency management, entry control, and building entry in conjunction with the Department of Homeland Security's *School Security Survey*.

Findings: No exceptions were noted as a result of applying these procedures

Recommendation: N/A

District Response: As indicated above, the District adopted the recommended policy no. 5170 on May 7, 2024.

Evacuation and Lockdown Drills

<u>Procedures Performed:</u> We reviewed the District's evacuation and lockdown drills conducted during the 2022-2023 school year as well as those drills conducted to date during the 2023-2024 school year to determine the following:

- A total of twelve drills were conducted during the 2022-2023 school year at various times throughout the school day;
- Eight of the twelve drills were evacuation drills;
- Four of the twelve drills were lockdown drills;
- Eight of the twelve drills were conducted prior to December 31st; and
- At least one early dismissal drill was conducted.

Findings: We noted the following in regard to the evacuation and lockdown drills:

• One out of five buildings did not complete the eight required evacuation drills in the 2022-2023 year and the schedule for the 2023-2024 year was going to be short as well. We noted Plainedge Middle School is now scheduled to meet the eight required evacuation drills in the 2023-2024 year.

Recommendation: We recommend the District implement controls to ensure that all required drills are conducted during the year, as well as done at the required increments, in accordance with Education law § 807. This should be inclusive of the eight evacuation school drills at any District building.

District Response: The District has reviewed the evacuation plans for next year and revisions were made in March 2024 to comply with Education Law § 807. In addition, effective July 1, 2024 each school building must submit their Evacuation and Lockdown Drill schedules to the Director of Facilities to ensure compliance.

School Security Guards

<u>Procedures Performed:</u> Tested a sample of District security guards to verify the following in accordance with NYS General Business Law Article 7-A § 89:

- The employee is registered as a security guard by the NYS Department of State Division of Licensing Services
- Employee files contained the following items:
 - o A completed employment application
 - Photograph of the employee
 - o Employee training records
 - o Fingerprint clearance
