**2024-2025:           \$441,517**

**2025-2026:           \$488,416**

**Year-to-year change: + \$46,899**



# Budget Drivers

- ▶ BOCES scheduling and referee services
- ▶ Sports equipment for specific sports
- ▶ Specific equipment for physical education and adapted physical education
- ▶ Supplies for physical education and every sport in high school and middle school
- ▶ Replacement, repair, reconditioning, and purchase of safety equipment and uniforms
